

What is Reformation Gospel Ministries (“RGM”)?

The Reformation Gospel Ministries project has as its goal the presentation of the riches and beauty of the 16th & 17th century Biblical & Reformed expressions of the Christian faith in a 21st century context. We seek bring the gospel message of Jesus Christ as revealed in the Bible and expressed in the confessions and creeds of the Protestant Reformation in a form that will make it easier for the reader to understand and apply the truths contained in them and to encourage them to further explore these original documents. But more importantly, as the Holy Spirit graciously works, the unbeliever will come to understand his own hopeless state before a holy and righteous God and his helpless condition without Jesus Christ, repent of his sins and come to faith in Jesus Christ, resting in Him alone for the forgiveness of sins, salvation, righteousness and everlasting life.

Furthermore, this project is designed to assist the church in her God-given responsibility to preach the Gospel and disciple the nations (Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:18-20). We seek to come alongside the church in order to give aid to her in accomplishing this divine mandate to spread the gospel message within the community where the church is located.¹ And with God’s blessing, according to His abounding grace, His church will increase until the last of His elect are brought into “the kingdom of the Son of His love,” Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:9; Colossians 1:13).

As part of this project, we will be field testing various ways of effectively engaging the audience. These will include conducting different types of evangelism events such as one-on-one distribution of gospel tracts (either door-to-door or in places of public gatherings (i.e., parks)) and canopy gospel events where the Biblical and Reformed Gospel message is proclaimed and will include gospel singing groups, singing Biblically sound lyrics in a variety of genres. After the message and the singing is done, a catered fellowship meal will be enjoyed where one-on-one witnessing opportunity will be provided that will also serve to answer questions and respond to concerns of those in attendance. Of course, the goal is to go out to the “highways and by-ways” and call as many as can be found to repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ, gathering them to the wedding feast, as it is described in Matthew 22:10 – so they might know the eternal comfort of belonging to our faithful Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Other events will be organized to give instruction on various Biblical topics (i.e., creation, authority of Scripture, the five “Solas,” evangelism and witnessing, etc.). As such, these types of events will serve to introduce Reformed principles of the Faith to those seeking clarity on the many precious jewels of truths mined from God’s word.

RGM’s first effort in this on-going project is in the form of a gospel tract, which is drawn from the Heidelberg Catechism. This tract is a summary of certain questions and answers that expose the depravity of mankind and how he came to a state of hopelessness and a condition of helplessness; that is, come into a state of sin and misery. It is from this state where there is no comfort - no life and peace -

that God Himself has saved and redeemed His chosen ones, who He chose from before the foundations of the world and without consideration before they had done any right or wrong, good or bad, or anything in them whatsoever, but of mere grace, having had set His love on them in eternity, for the sake His beloved Son, Jesus Christ. This is where we find our comfort – in Christ alone.
