#### Romans 1:8-15

#### Introduction

- Passion Drives the Energy behind any Pursuit in the Life, especially if that Pursuit comes out of Duty
- I. Of Passion (verses 8-13)
  - A. the Prayer of the Passion (verses 8-10)
    - Without Ceasing (verse 9)
    - Thanked the Lord for their Faith (verse 8)
    - Praying that it would be in God's will to get him to Rome (v. 10)
  - B. The Purpose behind the Passion a Humble Purpose (verses 11-13)
    - To "Impart Some Spiritual Gift" that They may be "Established" (verse 11; Romans 16:25; Ephesians 3:17-19)
    - To be "Encouraged" Together with Them (verse 12)
    - To Produce Fruit Among Them (verse 13)
      - > The Fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
      - The Salvation of Sinners (John 15:1-8; Matthew 9:36-38; John 4:24; 1 Corinthians 9:22)
- II. Of Duty "Debt" (Verses 14-15)
  - A. A Debt to the Gentiles (verse 14; Acts 26:15-18; Romans 8:1-17, especially verses 12-13; Isaiah 64:6; Luke 17:10)
  - B. Ready to Proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ (verse 15)
    - Of Passion, Of Duty
    - We are a Work in Progress Don't have all the Answers, but be a Faithful Servant of Jesus Christ in Witnessing God's Gospel to Others Knowing the "Terror of the Lord" (2 Corinthians 5:11)
