"The True Bread of God" **John 6:30-34 (John 6:22-40)**

Introduction

- Many people didn't grasp the spiritual nature of Jesus' teachings and the miracles demonstrating who He was and is

The Bread of God from Heaven Introduced (vs. 30-34)

- A sign was demanded by the people – Two Observations (vs. 30-31):
 - A. The request ignored the miracles/signs Jesus had already done – revealed the people's hardened, stubborn and ungrateful hearts
 - B. They missed the point in Jesus' statement concerning the food that endures to everlasting life (John 6:27; Matthew 16:1-4)
- Not answering their request, Jesus tells of the true Bread from heaven (vs. 32-33; Psalm 78:23-25; Deuteronomy 8:3)
 - The manna in the desert foreshadowed the true Bread of God from heaven
- The still didn't understand what Jesus was talking in the request they made (v. 34)
 - Blinded by their ignorance, they wanted what would make their lives more comfortable in this world (Malachi 1:2-3; Romans 9:9-13; Hebrews 12:16-17)
 - Their very soul was in jeopardy, not understanding the spiritual nature of the Bread being offered them would give them everlasting life – Bread received by faith, not with their hands

Conclusion and Application

- Are you seeking only the conveniences and pleasures of this life?
- Or, by the grace of God, have you repented from your rebellious and sinful living and embrace by faith alone the true Bread of God that came down from heaven, Jesus Christ?
- Are you continuing to walk by faith in the power of the Holy Spirit each day; so that others might see what is "that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God" in your walk of faith to the glory of God? (Romans 12:1-2)
